Stamp Out Hunger 2025

We joined the Stamp Out Hunger USPS Food Drive, and you helped us exceed 12,000 pounds of food! The largest amount ever!!

- We tripled last year's total
- \$30,000 in estimated food value
- A two month supply that will feed 1,600-2,000 familes!
